Community Service Projects:

1. Spring Flower Bed Clean-Up: mulching, weeding, edging, planting new flowers, etc.
2. Event Volunteers: Spring into Birding, Saucon Creek Art Festival, etc.

Sustainable Projects:

1. Install a brick/paver pathway from the front of the house to the left side (towards the back) of the house to make the homestead handicap accessible.



2. Create standing cardboard cut outs of historical people to be displayed at this location
3. Create a video of the history of this location that could be played on a continuous loop.
4. Recreate a historically accurate corn crib where it was originally located.
5. Repair/replace the crumbling front steps.



6. Sew new historically accurate costumes for docents.
7. Organize storage room with shelving and hanging options as well as label all bins.
8. Catalogue the contents of the homestead.
9. Create, build and install educational signage and building markers: for walking trail as well as all buildings and sites, including the main house, Widow's house, the area where the saw mill once was, the area where the corn crib was, the remains of the barn, and the existing spring house.
10. Create a usable open-air event space from the remains of the barn by removing pavement, rocks and debris and shoring up the foundation rock walls.
